CLASSIFICATION FOR AUGUST 2017

As many parents will be aware the local authority are currently reviewing all placing requests made across the city for children entering P1 in August. Until this exercise is complete and we know the number of P1s starting with us for the new school session we are unable to confirm the new classification for the school in August. It is expected that parents who have made a placing request will receive letters confirming their place on or around the 20^{th} April. We do anticipate that the school roll will increase to approximately 442 with around 22 staff and 16 classes. This will mean there will be at least two composite classes across the school. We hope to have more detail of our classification in next month's newsletter.

SUPPORTING YOUR CHILD THROUGH HOME LEARNING

Thank you for your continued support in enabling children to access Sumdog at home. We have now subscribed all classes to the reading and writing modules in Sumdog. When we return after the Spring Break, home learning will focus on this and encouraging children to read for pleasure through the continued use of book bags in P1-4 and research work in P5-7. A detailed information sheet will be issued when we return to school in April.

HEALTH WEEK

The week beginning 24th April will be our health week in school where we focus learning around all aspects of health. During this week all classes in the school will complete their Sexual Health & Relationship lessons as part of the progressive programme of work children began in their P1 year. Parents of Primary 1 are invited to attend an awareness raising meeting to discuss the content of this through school programme of lessons which we undertake every year. The meeting will take place at 6pm on Tuesday 18th April. An invitation with RSVP slip has been issued.

BOOK FAIR

From Tuesday 2^{nd} May - Friday 5^{th} May the school will host a book fair from Travelling Books. Children will have the chance to view books and take a brochure home with guidance on how to order should you wish to buy one. This is a 100% commission meaning the school will receive books for our library to the value of any purchases.

SPORTS DAYS

This year we plan to hold our sports events on two separate afternoons to allow us to use the school pitch. Sports afternoons will be held on 23^{rd} May at 1.30pm until 2.30pm for all children in P1-3. P4-7 will have their sports on Wednesday 24^{th} May at 1.30pm.

The format will be potted sports with children competing in house groups of mixed ages led by our P7 captains. Each group will complete sporting tasks at different 'stations' positioned around the pitch.

Parents/carers are welcome to attend but will not have access to the pitch area due to space restrictions. Spectators can view events from the newly re-turfed grass embankments around the pitch where some seating will be available.

If you are planning to join us on either or both of these days, please be aware that we will cancel the event if we have any concerns about the children's or spectator safety due to weather conditions on the day.

Spectators should plan to arrive at school no earlier than 1.15pm as children use the grounds until 1pm and staff need to prepare for the event.
