<u>Parentsportal</u>

Garrowhill Primary is one of the launch schools in the city for the use of Parentsportal. Thank you to the 50% of families who have linked to their child's Parentsportal account. If you have not done this, please help us by linking to your child's account now.

Parentsportal is a new digital service which will help to replace schoobag post by allowing families to update data checks, family information and consents online.

To login to Parentsportal; you need a MyGov account with Glasgow City Council. If you require any support with this, please contact the Clerical Team who will be happy to help.

Universal Free School Meals

Child Protection: Absence From School

It is the responsibility of all parents to inform the school, before 9am, of any absence from school. Failure to alert staff or the absence line that your child cannot attend causes concern for us under our child protection procedures. We must be satisfied that every child is accounted for on every school day.

When a parent or carer fails to inform the school/absence line our clerical staff can often spend the whole day trying to establish that the child is safe.

Please record your child's absence online or phone the dedicated absence team on: <u>0141 287 0039</u> from 8am on the first day of absence <u>AND</u> every subsequent day. It is important that the school is kept up to date during any long term absences.

Parents are strongly encouraged not to take their children out of school for family holidays. Should you wish to remove your child from school for any reason you <u>must</u> put your request in writing to the Head Teacher.

<u>Safe Routes to School</u>

Thank you to the families who are parking safely around our school perimeter. Please ensure when dropping off or collecting children that you park and drive carefully and are mindful of our neighbours and families crossing the road. Please keep all of the children safe by finding a safe place to park when dropping off or picking up at the end of the school day. Remember our drop-off zone can also be used in the morning.
